Subject :	NATO unclassified information

Following contacts with the NATO Secretariat in order to clarify the status and handling of NATO unclassified information, delegations are informed that:

- NATO documents which are marked NATO UNCLASSIFIED are released only for official purposes. Therefore, when distributed to delegations, they are <u>not</u> to be made public (unless NATO has given its prior consent);
- such documents must bear the marking LIMITE and are circulated to all delegations without limitations¹ (since they are not within the scope of the EU-NATO Security Agreement and its implementing arrangements);
- (iii) such documents must be handled in accordance with the "need-to-know" principle. It therefore follows that:
 - = the principle of originator control applies regarding the onward release of such documents to any third parties or the general public;
 - = delegations are responsible for ensuring that such documents are distributed only on a strict "need-to-know" basis.

¹ In the event of any extracts of such documents being included, with the consent of the originator, in official Council documents, the sub-code **NUCI** must be added. The handling rules mentioned in point (iii) apply.
