Notes:

1. The data covers forces in England and Wales, Scottish forces, the Police Service for Northern Ireland, Guernsey, Jersey, the Ministry of Defence Police etc.
2. The data was produced on 31/03/2007 and gives the ages of persons with a profile retained on the

National DNA Database as at 31/03/2007.

3. The age figures should be treated with caution as there are some data accuracy issues relating to the recording of dates of birth on the Police National Computer (PNC) by arresting police officers.

Key demographic data, such as the DOB data, is transferred electronically from the PNC to the NDNAD.

4. The figures given in column 3 are the number of DNA subject sample profiles held on the Database as at 31/03/2007. There are more profiles than individuals due to DNA samples being taken from some individuals on more than one occasion (ie due to replicate sampling). It is estimated that the current level of profile replication is approximately 13.7%.

5. The figures given in column 4 are the estimated number of individuals on the National DNA Database using the current level of replication.

6. The 'ethnic appearance' record is a record of the arrested person's visual appearance based on the judgement of the arresting police officer. It uses seven (6+1) broad categories. No ethnic appearance data is recorded for approx 10% of subject sample records on the Database; and is not recorded by forces in Scotland.
