Subject : **Case before the Court of Justice of the European Union:**  
- Case **C-355/10** (European Parliament v. Council of European Union)  
= Application under Article 263 TFEU for annulment of Council Decision  
2010/252/EU

---

1. By application under Article 263 TFEU, notified to the Council on 26 July 2010, the European Parliament asked the Court to annul Council Decision 2010/252/EU of 26 April 2010 supplementing the Schengen Borders Code as regards the surveillance of the sea external borders in the context of operational cooperation coordinated by the European Agency for the Management of Operational Cooperation at the External Borders of the Member States of the European Union <sup>1</sup>.
2. In support of its action for annulment, the European Parliament argues that the Council in adopting the contested decision exceeded the implementing powers set out in Article 12(5) of the Schengen Borders Code<sup>2</sup> to adopt additional measures governing border surveillance.
