The 3096th session of the Council of the European Union - **JUSTICE and HOME AFFAIRS** - will take place on Thursday 9 (10.00) and Friday 10 June (09.00) 2011, in the Conference Centre - FIL, 5, rue Carlo Hemmer, Luxembourg, under the chair of **Mr Sándor PINTÉR**, Minister for the Interior, and **Mr Tibor NAVRACSICS**, Minister for Justice.
