1. Background



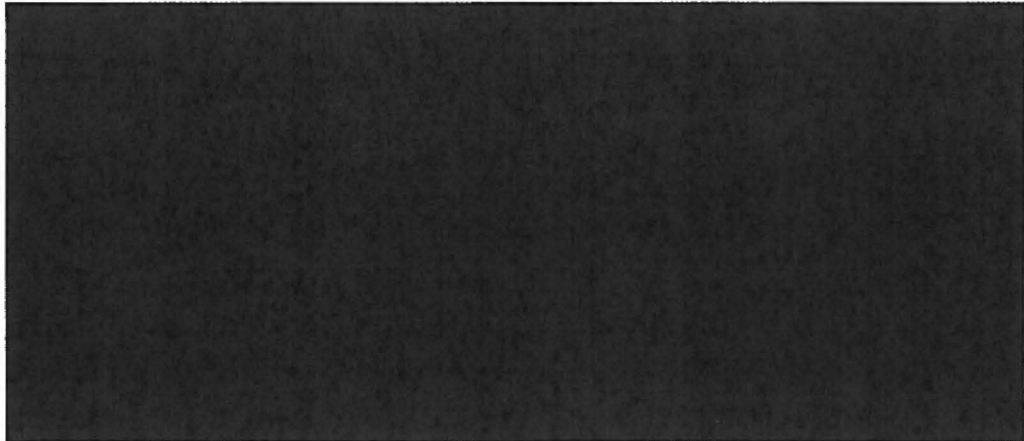

O14 presented the work of CSW¹ and covered new trends in covert surveillance and the reorganization of EUROPOL's operational department.

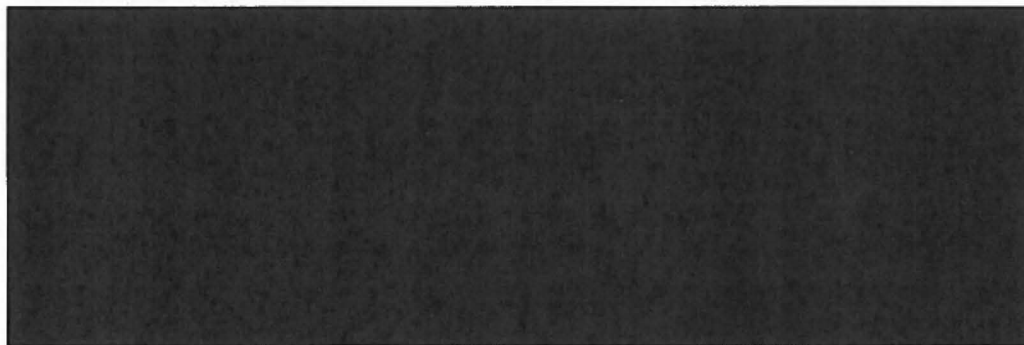
