<u>Page 7</u>, item **6**:

6. **Draft Convention on the crossing of external frontiers**

....

The second paragraph should read:

"The Commission representative *stressed the importance of this Convention for the free movement of persons and* announced that the Commission was considering the implications of the *persistent* deadlock *on this dossier*."

Page 10, item 12:

12. <u>Draft Protocol to the Convention on the protection of the Communities' financial interests</u>

. . . .

Add the following paragraph:

"The Commission representative announced the Commission's intention of submitting in the near future a new draft Protocol concerning the questions not covered by the Convention."

Page 14, item 17 (Other business), (c) and (e):

(c) Commission communication on the application of Article K.9

The text of the first paragraph of this item should read:

"The Council took note of an oral statement by the Commission representative concerning the Commission's communication to the European Parliament and the Council on the possible application of Article K.9 of the TEU."

(e) Commission communication on funding for Title VI

The text of this item should <u>read</u>:

"The Commission informed the Council of the European Parliament's criticisms of the procedure for selection of projects, drawing attention to the risks this entailed as regards *the budgets* for 1996 and 1997."
