Purpose and remit of the Advisory Group

The informal Advisory Group on Border Security Research has as main role to advise Frontex on priorities for Border Security Research.

The list of responsibilities:

- Providing continuous contribution to the planning and shaping of the mid- and long-term Border Security Research Agenda, in particular, in the context of shaping the 2014-2020 Border Security Research objectives and Topics of the Commission's Horizon 2020;
- Providing feedback on Frontex Research & Development activities, projects, their outcomes, and advising on prioritization of future R&D activities;
- Serving as a coordinated "collective" pool of end-user experts to advise, in representation of particular end-users needs, in the process of defining and shaping short-term Research & Development activities and endeavours.

The Advisory Group is meant to be informal in that sense that it:

- does not take any formal decisions, but rather provides advice and recommendations in written and/or oral form;
- acts as group of experts, who do not express in their advice/recommendation any opinion of a particular Member State, but represents a "collective" view.

There were no meetings of the Advisory Group in 2014.
