We present information in the same manner - Common product structure

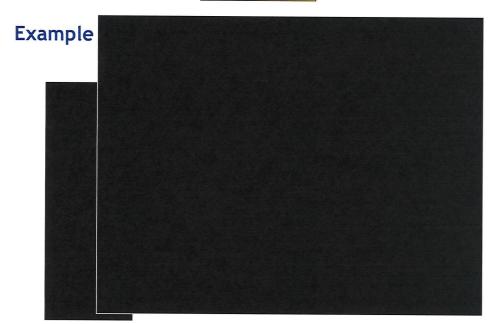
We share information - Common platform / network
