Tactical vs Operational


Operational Risk Analysis:






- Extend into the border continuum

Interoperability



- Similar capacities (strategic)
- Common risk awareness (operational)
- Cooperation & exchange (tactical)

Consequences of Inaction:

- Risk of coverage (threats not addressed in a uniform manner)
- Risk of divergence (un-harmonized practices)
- Risk of segmented cooperation (clusters of cooperation)
