1. Adoption of the agenda

The agenda was adopted as set out in CM 4436/21.

2. Afghanistan

Delegations received presentations by INTCEN, EEAS and the Commission on the latest developments in Afghanistan and had an exchange of views.

The EU CTC's office presented a draft Counter-Terrorism Action Plan on Afghanistan (11556/21). Following the exchange of views delegations were invited to send coordinated written comments to the TWP Secretariat.

3. EU-UK cooperation: elements of a possible CT dialogue

Following the presentation by the EEAS, delegation had an exchange of views on the substance of a possible EU-UK CT Dialogue. The issue will be further discuss in the UK Working Party.
