<u>Module 1:</u> Implementing rules concerning the processing of Operational Personal Data (OPD)

KEY DISCUSSION POINTS

- The importance and urgency to finalise these rules was stressed
- Definitions: It will be made sure that definitions are in line with the applicable legal framework
- Data Deletion and Data Anonymisation: Further thought will be given to how these concepts are applied in the draft
- Controllership and joint controllership: attention will be paid to make sure that the draft is internally
 consistent and in line with the data protection framework
- Defining the need of processing special categories of personal data was referred to
- Assessing proportionality and necessity in processing certain data as data related to minors will be considered
- Further clarity was offered that the collection of OPD does not occur only during Operations but also during other activities, i.e. monitoring migration flows or conducting risk analysis
- Data collection plan: it was clarified that it will be integrated in the operational plan where one exists (i.e. in the course of Operations). The data collection plan will be binding in that case
- The OPD rules should avoid contradictions between Frontex Implementing Rules and national laws
- Access to operational personal data by the Agency and deletion of data
- The applicability to SAC countries of the relevant EU data protection instruments referred to in the OPD rules will be assessed
