

Voluntary Returns - Syria

Resumption of support as of 17 March 2025

❖ Return Flights

- **19 MS** have returned **5911 Syrian nationals** with Frontex assistance between 17/03/2025-31/12/2025
- **76%** of TCNs were returned by **Cyprus (39%)** and **Germany (37%)**

❖ Reintegration Support

- **EURP** support available with over **2837 beneficiaries** so far.

Voluntary Returns - Afghanistan

Resumption of support as of 24 of November 2025

❖ Return Flights

- **10 third-country nationals** were returned with the support of the Agency until 8 January 2026.

❖ Reintegration Support

- **EURP** support available for voluntary returns **since early December** through grant with IRARA.
- **8 TCN beneficiaries** registered for EURP so far.

63 493 effective returns supported
13% year-on-year increase
