Jean Charles de Menezes was shot dead on 22nd July 2005 at Stockwell tube station by Metropolitan Police officers. Despite two official IPCC investigations and a guilty jury verdict at the Health and Safety trial at the Old Bailey no officer has ever been held to account for their actions. On **22nd September 2008**, the **inquest** into his death will finally take place. The inquest will be the first opportunity the Menezes family have had to ask their questions and confront the police officers involved in the operation in a public court.

The Jean Charles de Menezes Family Campaign was set up in 2005 by Jean Charles's relatives to:

- Find out the truth about Jean Charles' death
- Bring all those responsible for his death to justice
- Campaign to end the 'shoot-to-kill' policy and prevent a similar tragedy happening again.

The **inquest**, which takes place at the **Oval Cricket Ground** in south London and is likely to take three months to complete, may bring us a little nearer to the truth, but is limited in its scope. It is no substitute for a full judicial public inquiry to investigate the police operation, the actions of the police following Jean Charles' death and the state's 'shoot-to-kill' policy.
