## **Ensuring the availability of data for the purposes of prevention and prosecution of crime**

The mind map in attachment summarises the main options and related elements identified thus far for ensuring the availability of communication data that could be eventually used for the purposes of prevention and prosecution of crime. The mind map is based on written contributions by delegations and expert exchanges throughout the discussions on that matter. It is not exhaustive and is intended to be a living document.

The Presidency invites an exchange of views on the presented options with a view to identifying the feasibility of each of them to guide future work.

Regarding the draft ePrivacy Regulation in particular, a joint meeting with the Working Party on Telecommunications and Information Society is provisionally planned in October 2017. The objective of the discussion at the DAPIX - FoP meeting is to streamline the possible elements that could be addressed in the context of the ePrivacy Regulation with a view to proceeding to a substantive discussion at the joint meeting in October.

**Delegations are invited to present their views on the options, while assessing the advantages and disadvantages of the various elements, as well as to indicate their views on the way forward with a view to streamlining or complementing the options available.**
