<p>Session evacuation of plane and ferry</p>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Perform an emergency evacuation during readmission operations by sea in accordance to operational standards. 2. Perform an emergency evacuation during readmission operations by air in accordance with airline standards.
<p>Session HCG sea rescue activities, emergency evacuation of the boat</p>	<p>Get information about emergency procedures on a boat</p>
